And how doing so takes parking spaces away from paying customers. Please consider the following alternatives.

WHERE TO PARK

Municipal parking lots offer free, unlimited parking. Locations include:

- ➤ Glendon Street lot; adjacent to walking/biking path
- Railroad Avenue, a smaller lot located along the "back way" to Glendon St. lot; adjacent to walking/biking path
- Additional newly paved spaces also on Railroad Ave. next to former freight building.
- Next to 91 Center St; easy access to any direction, and to walking/biking path
- Mast Landing on Center St; adjacent to walking/biking path

In addition to municipal lots, unlimited parking is available here:

- South Main St: South of Union to the intersection of Main & Center St (Pickering Corner)
- North Main St: from Sewall Road to Friend Street
- Behind Carpenter School on South Main St next to Town Hall: When school is not in session.

PARK & RIDE SHUTTLE

➤ July and August, 2023: Departs Kingswood Art Center, stops at Wolfeboro Municipal Parking Lot located at the corner of North Center St/109A, stops at former railroad station (information center), returns to Kingswood Art Center. All the details at www.wolfeborotrolley.com 603-569-1080.
